Oct. 13, 2021 (Falls Church, Va.) – The IAEM-USA Awards & Recognition Committee of the International Association of Emergency Managers (IAEM) is pleased to announce the winner of the IAEM-USA Student Ally of the Year. The award will be presented at the Monday Networking Luncheon and Awards Ceremony on Oct. 18, 2021, at the 69th IAEM Annual Conference & EMEX, in Grand Rapids, Michigan.

The winner of the 2021 IAEM-USA Student Ally of the Year is Walter English, III, CEM.

Walter has been a major supporter of students this past year. He helped start a Student Engagement Task Force to increase student participation within their regions. He worked with other regional presidents and IAEM Headquarters staff to look at college chapters and how to increase participation and reach more students.
