The award will be presented at the Monday Networking Luncheon and Awards Ceremony on Nov. 14 at the 70<sup>th</sup> IAEM Annual Conference & EMEX, in Savannah, Georgia.

#### **Allison Moore, CEM Winner of the IAEM-USA Career Excellence Award**

Allison Moore, CEM, has been in the emergency management field for more than 20 years and has been involved in every level of emergency management. Recently, she has been helping grow the profession and IAEM membership within Indiana as well as nationwide with her new position. Moore has been active on the IAEM Conference Committee and the Public Private Partnership Committee. She has also been involved with the Citizens Climate Lobby, which is the fastest climate advocacy group looking at the effects of climate change. Additionally, Moore is the Indiana State representative on the IAEM-USA Region 5 Board and has helped many programs and initiatives that have been shared with other regions across IAEM.

Moore was one of three people who helped lead the efforts for the Region 5 virtual symposium and has helped increase communications and memberships. Indiana has one of the smallest membership totals in the region, and she has worked hard to build that up over the last few years. She has also been a Red Cross blood leader over the last few years, and her blood drive totals were third highest in the state of Indiana. There is no measure to the number of lives she saved in this role and the good she does the community. Moore is striving to make a difference in the profession, her community, and the nation to make it a better place for the next generation.
