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




Demographics









- 5% Pursuing Associates Degrees

 Management Program as "Excellent"


- 63% see a gap between academics and practical experience

Work Experience






Armed Forces


- 36% of students have served in the armed forces

Service in the Armed Forces




Deployed in support of emergency relief operations

- 75% have never worked as an intern during their academic program



- 78% never received help in searching for EM and other related jobs


Volunteerism


- 39% currently volunteer

Principals of Emergency Management






How familiar do you think your university is with the PEM
