POSITION PAPERS

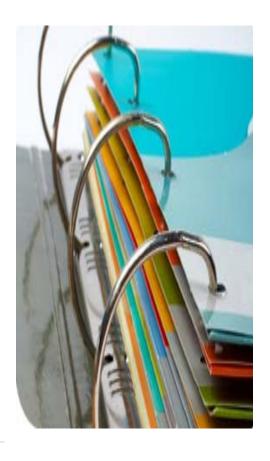
From time to time, the Association may issue position papers on pertinent public policy issues. The Board of Directors

may formally identify issues and adopt a policy, may refer the matter to an existing or special committee for deliberation and investigation, or may vote to not endorse any policy on the issue.

Any member aware of issues affecting the Association and its membership should forward such information to a member of the Board of Directors.

A majority vote of the Board of Directors is required for the dissemination of an official position paper.
