Key Dates

June 1, 2020

- Deadline to submit your application to be an EMvision Talks speaker.
- The initial application only requires two things:
 - An abstract describing your EMvision talk
 - A short bio



July 20, 2020

- Deadline to submit a video of your proposed EMvision talk
- IAEM will contact prospective speakers to submit a video of their proposed EMvision talk no later than June 19, 2020.



August 14, 2020

- IAEM will notify speakers if they are selected to present an EMvision talk at IAEM 2020.

All selected speakers will receive a discount off the full registration rate equivalent to half off the early bird member full registration fee for the conference
