## Key Dates

May 7, 2021

- Deadline to submit your application to be an EMvision Talks speaker.
- The initial application only requires two things:
  - An abstract describing your EMvision talk
  - A short bio



June 01, 2021

- IAEM notifies speakers of selection into Round 2- video submission.



July 1, 2021

- Deadline to submit video of proposed Talk.
- IAEM will notify speakers by July 30th if they are selected to present an EMvision talk at IAEM 2021.

Selected speakers will receive a complimentary basic registration to the conference.
