## About NIMAA.

NIMAA is a mutual aid process for colleges and universities to share resources across the United States. It does not require an emergency and can be used for preparation, response and recovery functions. It spans the nation but is encouraged to be used locally/regionally.

## 2015

NIMAA was launched after an extensive review by numerous institutions, FEMA, the Department of Homeland Security, and the Department of Education.

# Who's Involved?

111 Signatories to date - All 10 FEMA Regions and 26 states are represented in NIMAA - 53 Universities, 34 Community Colleges, 28 Research 1 Institutions, 24 State Universities, and 16 Division 1 FBS Schools. Many other institutions are interested!
