<u>Championing Collaboration in Intra-Governmental Preparedness: The</u> <u>Salt Lake County Continuity Cup</u>

Beginning in 2025, Salt Lake County Government established the Continuity Cup as a method to sustain continuity programming, safety and security, crisis communications, and preparing the Policy Group. To enhance engagement and participation, Salt Lake County partnered with public safety agencies and partner organizations to create an immersive week-long, scenario-based exercise, which allows participants from all facets of county government and public safety to learn about functions and capabilities in blue, gray, and dark sky days.
