Apply Domestic Preparedness Principles in an International Setting

Domestic preparedness principles, such as plan development, organizing and equipping, training, exercising, and evaluating, can be applied in an international setting. With a true understanding of how each of these areas practically work they can be applied in an international context. This poster will show the application of the Preparedness Cycle in the development of a training program in Europe, focused on the training of health professions in the first ever cohort of Emergency Preparedness and Response trainees for the European CDC.
