## Comparisons of State and IAEM-USA Certifications within Region 4

**The Online CEM/AEM Application Portal is now active** for initial CEM/AEM credential submissions, AEM to CEM upgrade applications, Lifetime applications, and those recertifying. CEM/AEM candidates submitting **first-time** applications may submit through the online system *or* by using the paper application until Aug. 15, 2014. After Aug. 15, *all* applications must be submitted through the online system.

Candidates should note that starting July 1, 2014, applications must meet the new requirements included in the revised version of the CEM/AEM Application.
