IAEM LETTER TO FCC ON PROTECTION OF NWS SPECTRUM

Yesterday, IAEM-USA submitted a letter to the Federal Communications Commission on RM-11681 which details IAEM-USA's objections to Ligado's, a private company, request to share the NWS satellite down link frequencies. IAEM believes that sharing the frequencies will interfere with ground stations reception of NWS satellite data, potentially blocking reception of the satellite data. The comment period is open through midnight tonight, if you would like to submit your own letter. You may also submit IAEM's letter and indicate your support of it. NEW GRANT FUNDING OPPORTUNITY: COUNTERING VIOLENT EXTREMISM

On December 18, 2015, Congress passed the *Department of Homeland Security Appropriations Act, 2016* (Public Law 114-113). Sec 543 of the Act and the accompanying Joint Explanatory Statement provide \$10 million for "a countering violent extremism (CVE) initiative to help states and local communities prepare for, prevent, and respond to emergent threats from violent extremism."

Congress further instructed that "...all funds under the CVE initiative shall be provided on a competitive basis directly to states, local governments, tribal governments, nonprofit organizations, or institutions of higher education. Eligible activities for the CVE initiative shall include, but not be limited to, planning, developing, implementing, or expanding educational outreach, community engagement, social service programs, training, and exercises, as well as other activities as the Secretary [of Homeland Security] determines appropriate."

DHS will announce more details about the grant opportunity and the opening of the application period in the coming weeks. DHA provided an <u>Information Sheet</u>.
