Membership:

As of 2-9-2017 there are 4,122 paid IAEM members, of which 3,582 are within the USA Council. These counts include 605 from the Global Student Council (572 are within the USA Council). When including unpaid members there are 5,510 total members, of which 4,239 are within the USA Council. The great majority of the unpaid members are those within the 90-day grace period who have not yet renewed. The unpaid members also include Lifetime, Complimentary and Staff (about 93 total).

• Facebook likes have grown to 3,821. IAEM has 16,444 followers on Twitter. There are now 4,074 active participants in the IAEM LinkedIn Group.

Scholarship: The Scholarship Commission is developing the application for 2017.

 At its meeting in January, the Commission unanimously voted to annually name an undergraduate scholarship in memory of Robert Bohlmann. Once named, members will be informed.
