Membership:

As of 12-13-2016 there are 4,020 paid IAEM members, of which 3,500 are within the USA Council. These counts include 611 from the Global Student Council (580 are within the USA Council). When including unpaid members there are 5,545 total members, of which 4,243 are within the USA Council. The great majority of the unpaid members are those within the 90-day grace period who have not yet renewed. The unpaid members also include Lifetime, Complimentary and Staff (about 93 total).
