- Membership As of 09-13-2015 there are 4,133 paid IAEM members, of which 3,580 are within the USA Council (7,224 total members, of which 6,284 are within the USA Council). Last year on 09-01-2014 there were 5,170 paid members in good standing of which 4,311 were within the USA Council. Of the 4,149 total members who joined under Invite-a-Friend March 1-August 31, 2014, 601 (14.49%) have renewed/paid for a new \$185 membership as of 09-14-2015.
- Social Media Facebook likes have grown to 2,734. There are now 3,270 active participants in the IAEM LinkedIn Group. There are 1,912 followers of the IAEM LinkedIn Company page. IAEM has 12,961 followers on Twitter.
