

Troy McQuinn Bio

Since Troy began his career as a paramedic over 25 years ago, he has worked in many facets of emergency services. His career has extended from work as a front-line Paramedic to his current role as Manager, Emergency Preparedness & Business Continuity for Extra-Mural / Ambulance New Brunswick - the provincial ambulance and community healthcare delivery system in New Brunswick.

Troy has managed the emergency preparedness program for Extra-Mural / Ambulance New Brunswick from 2007. Over his tenure, he has developed emergency plans to a mature state that enables strong linkages within the public safety and healthcare communities for emergency responses to both planned and unplanned events. His time at EM/ANB has been punctuated by managing significant events that includes historical flooding of the Saint John River in 2018 & 2019, impacts due to global pandemics, and many mass gathering event medical response teams.

Since March 2020, Troy has led the Incident Command cadre of the Provincial Rapid Outbreak Management Team (PROMT) in New Brunswick; a multi-agency/multi-disciplinary team that rushes into COVID-19 outbreaks within 24 hrs of a first positive case in the most vulnerable population settings. This team has celebrated successes in implementing aggressive public health measures, treating affected persons in-place, and containing COVID outbreaks to the adult-residential facility care setting where it occurs, thereby limiting impacts on hospital-based healthcare delivery.

Troy has many skills, qualifications and experiences that he brings to his emergency management work. He hopes to work with the Atlantic Region team to continue elevating the emergency management profession.
