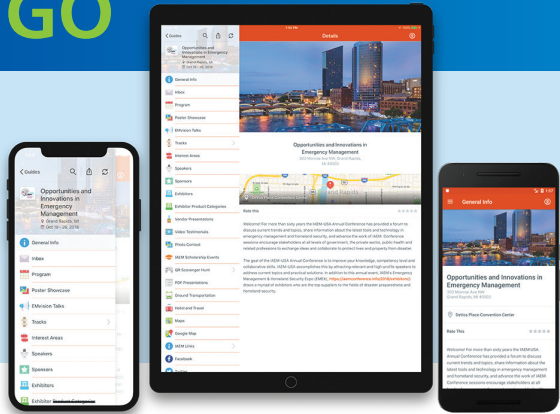

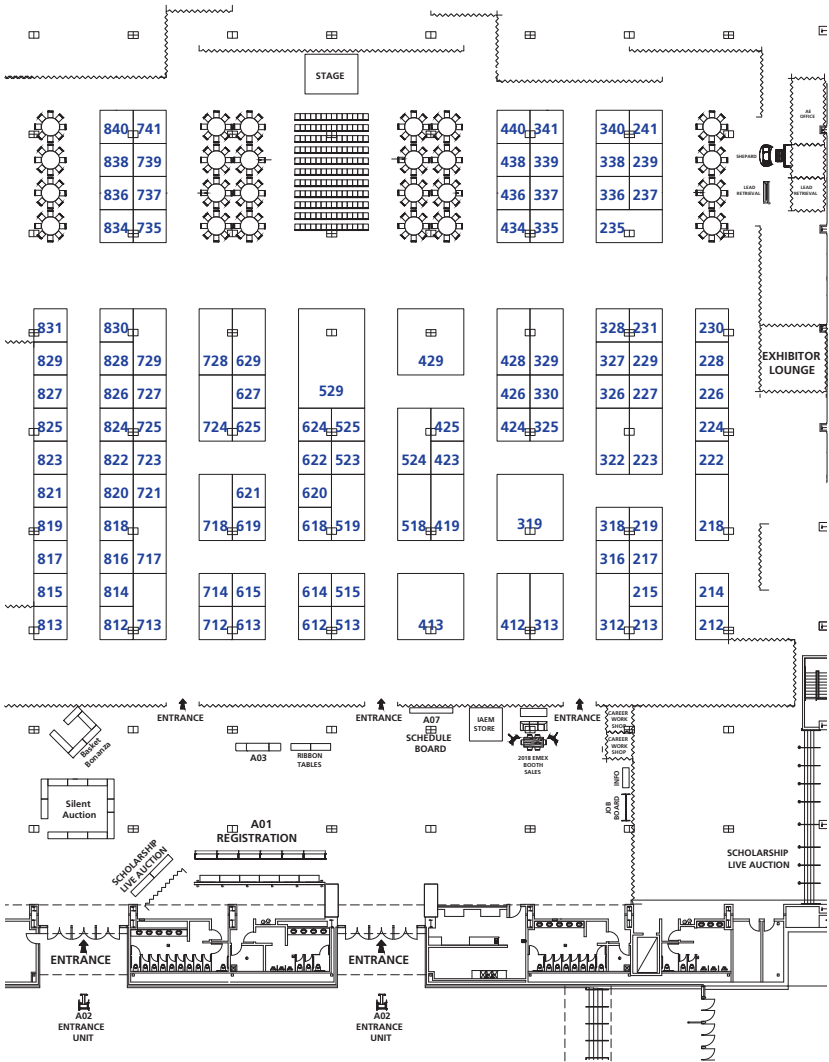

The Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training (ALERRT) Center at Texas State University has trained more than 130,000 first responders to active attacks since 2002. In FY18, we trained 30,388 law enforcement, fire, dispatch, and EMS, and 213,704 civilians in integrated active attack response.

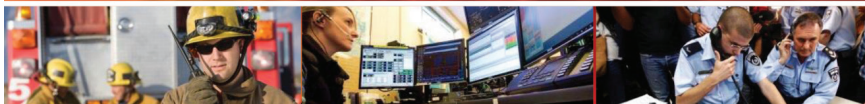

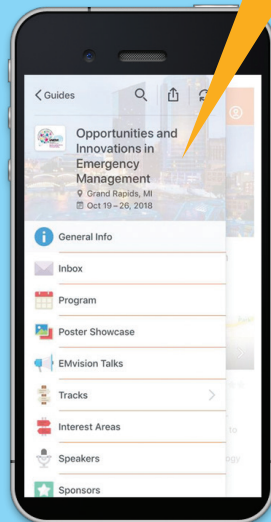

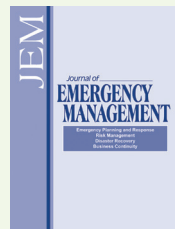
