### **Pertinent Information**

Commissioners represent many sectors, including: all levels of government, private sector, military, not-for-profit, higher education, healthcare, and consultants.

Commissioners are expected to work up to 20-hours in review months taking between 12-20 applications based on volume. That is a minimum of 120+-hours

> Commissioner serve a three year term and may be reappointed for an additional three years.


Each submitted application has at least two Commissioner review that application. Any resubmissions are reviewed by another set of two Commissioners. If Commissioner disagree on an applicant a third Commissioner conducts a review. The Chair and Vice Chair can review applications as a third reviewer or resolve issues.


>The work of the Certification Commission would not be possible without the dedicated and consistent support of the IAEM Staff.


## **Major Accomplishments**


